Release PV820 SV100

The theme of this release is enhancements to Application Control Manager.

Prerequisites

- This release requires a minimum OneStreamPlatform version 8.2 to install.
- This release supports an over-install from Application Control Manager version 740 and above. This version of Application Control Manager is not fully browser-compatible. Until the announcement of full browser compatibility, please do not submit support tickets related to browser issues.
- Any modifications to business rules, connectors, defaults Import Add-On components must be redone. Reach out to your OneStream Software representative for questions regarding the over-install process.
- After installing this release onto OneStreamPlatform version 8.2:
 - If the dashboard does not display as expected, either manually reset IIS or recompile the "ACM" Assemblies. You may need to recompile again to remove the errors.
 - If an error is encountered when creating Request Profiles, reset IIS.
- OneStream strongly recommends uninstalling the UI for Application Control Manager before installation. Any modifications to business rules must be redone.

New

- Introducing the redesign of both the Request Home and Request Details pages. Redesigned features include:

- Reduced click paths make navigating requests more efficient and easy to follow.
- Tiles representing as Filters to dynamically change criteria listed within the Request Home Grid
- Actionable Home buttons are now display-only based on the request status and the user's role.
- Tree-Hierarchy navigation has been introduced to simplify the member selection process.
- Layout assignments have been removed for the Copy, Move, Remove, and Delete actions to improve dynamic dashboard performance.
- The Comment capability has been simplified and expanded.

Enhancements

- The relationship properties of extended members can now be updated through user-initiated requests. (MP4-4333)
- Users can now add attachments to Completed or Closed request tickets. (MP4-4145)
- Remaining ACM Business Rules have been converted to ACM Workspace Assembly. (MP4-3962)
- Metadata Import will now require one process when having multiple varying property lines in source file. (MP4-4418)
- Use Mass update to change a user's Group Memberships without needing to list out groups already assigned to the user. (MP4-5021)

Fixed

- A single member with multiple parents in separate hierarchies will create a single update for the shared member. (MP4-3731)

- Metadata File Import references Member Filters as defined in the Dimensions table to generate line-items only for the specified hierarchy. (MP4-3802)
- The Required Field is enforced on the Process step. (MP4-3819)
- The Metadata File Import process can be run with a Non-English culture without generating an error. (MP4-4535)
- When doing a Metadata File Import, non-default Scenario Types with a blank Workflow Channel will reset to (Default Scenario Type). (MP4-4656)
- When account property IS IC Account is set to Conditional, the conditional setting will remain after committing the request. (MP4-4679)
- Security Role [Application Administrator] grants Application Administrator access based on the selection made. (MP4-4889)
- The Bridge Metadata Audit to Application Control Manager With Details report is running without producing an error after security requests are closed. (MP4-5008)
- Adding entity relationships to members in other entity dimensions will add a Copy line item for the extended member. (MP4-5012)
- Line items can be viewed/edited when adding a member while Parent In Request is turned on. (MP4-5135)
- Editing a Request Profile with Open request will now close the request instead of completing the request. (MP4-5139)
- The None member relationship and properties are included when exporting a dimension. (MP4-5193)

Known Issues

- For User Security request type, if the layout for Process step is different from the Initiate step, current values are not showing up correctly in the new value columns causing incorrect updates to the existing values for the user. (MP4-5045).

Table of Contents

- Interim workaround: Ensure the layouts are the same in both the Initiate and Process steps.
- Extracting the configuration file from this release ACM 820 SV100 and then loading it back to the same version does not set the selected action check-boxes as expected. (MP4-5092)
- .Tree must be capitalized in the dimension setup in order to submit a request. (MP4-5142)
