# Genesis Designer: Groups & Pages Configuration (GV200)

The foundation of any Genesis User Experience starts with configured Groups and Pages

## Application Groups

### Application Groups



### Home:

Provides a structured interface

### Admin:

Use to monitor and maintain ongoing application aspects

### Config:

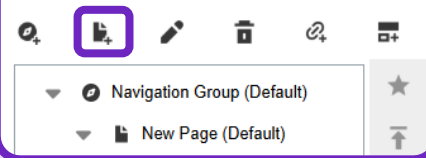
Use to focus on the initial solution setup

### Help:

Serves as a central point for self-service help across user types and processes

## Pages

### Navigation Groups & Pages

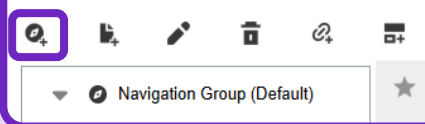


Pages should relate to the Navigation Group.

Click **New Page** to add a page.

## Navigation Groups

### Navigation Groups & Pages

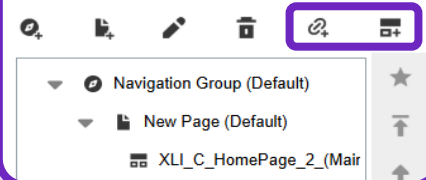


All Genesis builds start with a Navigation Group - a grouping of similar pages.

Click **New Navigation Group** to add a group.

## Content

### Navigation Groups & Pages



**Link** to an existing dashboard from a Shared Workspace.

**Inject** a Content Block, then configure the content.
